SVC encourages people to raise issues of data breaches and whilst breaches in data security / confidentiality are disciplinary offences, each case will be considered individually and for minor breaches or first offences the organisation will support the individual at fault, in conjunction with their supervisor to ensure they have an understanding of why the breach occurred and their responsibilities for data protection going forward.

Failure to inform the organisation of a data breach will be regarded as a serious offence and addressed under the organisation's Disciplinary Procedures.
